
LTS Map and Directions



LTS Map and Directions

From Fort Meade / BWI / Baltimore:

- 1. Take MD-295 South
- 2. Take exit for MD-193 West (toward College Park)
- 3. Turn Right on Metzerott Road
- 4. Turn Right on Greenmead Drive
- 5. Drive through the Veterinary School's parking lot to the LTS entrance
- 6. Turn left into LTS parking lot

From Dulles / Northern VA / Points West:

- 1. Take I-495 Inner Loop (toward Baltimore)
- 2. Take MD-650 South, New Hampshire Ave
- 3. Turn Left on Adelphi Road
- 4. Turn Left on Metzerott Road
- 5. Turn Left on Greenmead Drive
- 6. Drive through the Veterinary School's parking lot to the LTS entrance
- 7. Turn left into LTS parking lot

Using Shuttle-UM Bus System:

- The following lines may be useful for getting to the new LTS
- LTS is located just east (5 minute walk) of the Courtyards Apartment complex
- University ID NOT REQUIRED for the shuttle lines listed below

Campus Connector / Courtyards Express Day line:

- Student Union (stop #1) -> Courtyards (stop #10) -> AV Williams (stop #13) -> Regents Garage (stop #15)
- 2. Monday through Friday, 7:30am to 5:30pm

Courtyards Express line:

- Regents Garage (stop #1) -> Courtyards (stop #6) -> Regents Garage (stop #11)
- o Monday through Friday, 7:00am to 5:30pm, only when classes are in session.

• Purple line:

- Regents Garage (stop #11) -> Courtyards (stop #18) -> Regents Garage (stop #24)
- o Every Day, 5:30pm to 3:00am, during fall and spring semester

College Park Metro Station line:

- Student Union (stop #1) -> CP Metro Station (stop #4) -> Regents Drive (stop #7)
- Monday through Friday, 6:00am to 10:00pm
- Weekends, 6:30am to 8:00pm

Using DC Metro System:

- From the College Park Metro station
 - Take the UM Shuttle to campus, walk to either the Regents Garage or Student Union (5 minutes), and transfer to one of the Courtyards Express lines
- From the Greenbelt Metro station
 - Take the WMATA R3 Metrobus to the corner of Greenmead and Metzerott road
 - o The R3 line operates 6am to 8pm on weekdays, and 9am to 7pm on weekends
 - Bus departure times from the Greenbelt station are infrequent, so consult bus schedule on WMATA website

Entry Requirements

The new LTS facility is located near the University of Maryland campus in College Park. Entry to the first-floor SCIF is limited to TS/SI cleared individuals. At least one of the following is required:

- Blue or Green IC Badge
- Orange or Purple NSA Badge
- · Active NSA VR with "LTS" specified as an entry gate
